

Travel Policy

Policy for travel to Coalition of National Nursing & Midwifery Organisation meetings

Member organisations can apply for travel assistance to attend the CoNNMO meetings. Assistance will be for one economy class return air fare (within Australia) for one representative from each of the member organisations of the Coalition of National Nursing & Midwifery Organisations to attend meetings.

1. The Secretariat will advise CoNNMO members, six weeks prior to meetings, of the closing date for applications for funding to attend the next meeting of the CoNNMO. This notification will occur electronically. Application forms and the CoNNMO travel policy are available on the CoNNMO website.
2. Applications must be received by the Secretariat four weeks prior to the meeting. Applications must state the preferred itinerary and a formal quote for the airfare. Other costs associated with air travel (eg parking and taxis) will not be funded.
3. Applications will be considered in light of previously funded applications and funds available.
4. Member organisations will be notified about their application for travel funding two weeks prior to the meeting. Travel will then be arranged by the CoNNMO secretariat and details forwarded to the CoNNMO representative.
5. Travel costs for CoNNMO members (including overnight accommodation) to travel to a capital city (for rural and remote members) can be negotiated with the Secretariat.
