Objective 2: Provide national leadership in debates on health and public policy.

Establish structured process regarding development of CoNNMO policy and position statements	Encourage the membership to provide environmental scanning / issues for CoNNMO discussion / comment for further development to position statements as appropriate
Publicise CoNNMO policy and position statements	Publicise via website; email; and distribution to relevant stakeholders.
Influence broader policy development	Encourage member organisations to respond to consultation documents and draft policy, as appropriate.



Objective 3: Be a forum for discussion and consultation on professional matters.

CoNNMO will:

Strategies	Activities
Be a forum for discussion	 Hold twice yearly meetings and teleconferences as required. Where possible identify key issues and develop consensus positions
Exchange/share information	Exchange relevant information and research through email network and meetings.
Conduct consultation between members	Share resources and ideas through email network and meetings on professional nursing and midwifery matters.

Objective 4: Facilitate communication between members and other stakeholders.

Distribute information to members regarding Coalition activities	Distribute email notices of relevant events/research/media;

community of CoNNMO	Maintain and update website;
activities/positions	Produce an annual overview of achievements.

Objective 5: Be a primary conduit for access within and to the nursing and midwifery professions.

Contribute to the development of professional frameworks	 Encourage member organisations to contribute to the development of national standards for professional practice; Share standards of practice developed by member organisations with CoNNMO members and other stakeholders.
Promote the professions of nursing and midwifery	 Representation on committees, forums, conferences, and publication of CoNNMO positions.



Objective 6: Assist the development of governance and capacity of member organisations.

CoNNMO will:

Strategies	Activities
Identify existing resources	 Exchange documentation and resources; Encourage utilisation of governance standards; Encourage member organisations to act as mentors to one another.
Develop detailed membership database	Update membership database and website accordingly.
Encourage effectiveness of organisations	Maintain governance resources accessible through the CoNNMO website.

Objective 7: Remain robust using principles of good governance.

CoNNMO will:

Strategies	Activities
Develop effective processes for CoNNMO functioning	 Decide on and formally identify CoNNMO Chairperson; Develop and document meeting processes and schedule; Promote continuity of attendance; Utilise and implement Terms of Reference; Ensure due process for nomination of CoNNMO representatives to Council.
Review Terms of Reference	Council to identify and recommend changes to Terms of Reference to address inconsistencies and improvements.
Ensure a sound financial base for CoNNMO	 Connict Secretariat to obtain funding for Coalition activities and report on finances and funding to the Department of Health and Connict Secretarian Explore opportunities for additional funding.
Develop/review strategic plan	Undertake review every four years.
