





## **HEALTH MINISTERS' MEETING (HMM)**

Progress health issues of national importance which require cross-border collaboration. Made up of the health ministers of each state and territory government and the Australian Government Minister for Health and Aged Care. (coordinated via Health Ministers' Coordination Unit.

## **HEALTH CHIEF EXECUTIVES FORUM (HCEF)**

Intergovernmental forum for joint decision-making and strategic policy discussions that helps to efficiently deliver health services in Australia. Made up of the health department chief executive officer from each state and territory and the Australian Government. (coordinated via Health Ministers' Coordination Unit)

## **HEALTH WORKFORCE TASKFORCE (HWT)**

**Purpose:** To progress health workforce priorities identified by Health Ministers and provide advice and recommendations to ensure there is a sufficient and sustainable current and future health workforce to meet the health needs of Australians.

The Taskforce is time-limited (initially to 12 months) and reports to the HMM via the HCEF, with clear prioritised work plans developed.

Tiger teams are convened as required.
